Area investment firm buys two Schaumburg offices

The immediate area surrounding the newly opened Renaissance Convention Center in Schaumburg is the breeding ground for hot properties.

Adding flames to the growing fire is Woodridge firm Ardmir Properties Real Estate Investment Group, which recently purchased Woodfield Green Executive Centre across the street from the "RenCen."

The complex features two single-story buildings totaling more than 109,000 square feet of office space. Major tenants include Sun Trust Mortgage, Omron, Coleman Floor Co., Tracy Cross and Taiyo Yuden.

Transwestern Commercial Services sold the twin buildings, located at 1920 and 1930 Thoreau Drive, for an undisclosed amount.
